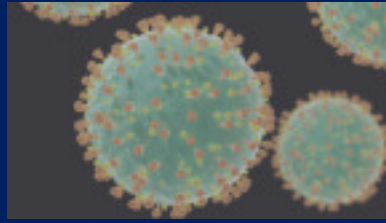


# Questions for Christians During Coronavirus
